Instructor Information:

Dr. Duane Dobbert is a 40 year veteran of the Criminal Justice profession, serving in investigative, clinical, administrative, research, academic and expert witness capacities. He is a Fellow of the American College of Forensic Examiners and the Board of Psychological Specialties. He has consulted in thousands of criminal justice jurisdictions and school districts throughout the United States. Dr. Dobbert has also served on a Domestic Violence Fatality Review Team and is a member of the SW Florida Department of Law Enforcement CART (Child Abduction Response Team).

Dr. Dobbert is currently a Full Professor of Criminal Forensic Studies at Florida Gulf Coast University. He is currently writing his next book, *Family Violence in the 21st Century; A Change in Paradigm* and completing a comparative research analysis of sexual pathology between the United States and 12 industrialized nations. Dr. Dobbert is also conducting researching on the women who commit homicide.

Dr. Dobbert is the Forensic Psychology Series Editor for Praeger/ABC-CLIO Publishing. His first 2 books, *Halting the Sexual Predators Among Us (2004)* and *Understanding Personality Disorders (2007)* have received international recognition. Dr. Dobbert's 3rd book, *Psychopathy, Perversion, and Lust Homicide* was released internationally on June 30, 2009. It is a comparative analysis of the psychopathy and sexual paraphilias of 22 serial killers. Dr. Dobbert blends his extensive career with the theoretical perspectives of his three books to provide new insight into the relationship between family violence and stranger violence.
